PUMPKIN DIP FOR APPLES

3/4 cup cream cheese

1/2 cup brown sugar

1/2 cup canned pumpkin

2 teaspoons maple syrup

1/2 teaspoon cinnamon

Apple slices marinated in pineapple juice and blotted dry

Cream together cream cheese and brown sugar. Add pumpkin, maple syrup, and cinnamon. Mix well (can put in food processor), serve with apple slices.

Can make entire plate up a day ahead. The apple slices marinated in pineapple juice do not go brown!
