Evergreen?: Leaves die back with frost

Height: 2'-3'Spread: 3'-5'

Light: Full Sun (Partial Shade)Water: Tolerates wet soil!

Common Name: Firecracker plant

Native: Southern India & Sri Lanka

Bloom time: Summer

Height: 1-3 feetWidth: 1-2 feet

Exposure: Sun or Shade

Winter Hardiness: 30-32° F. Hates

frost.

Irrigation: High Water Needs

Common Name: Stromanthe

Winter Hardiness: Zone 9. Needs protection

Bloom time: Spring or Summer

Height: 3'-5'

Width: 2'-3'

Exposure: Shade/ Morning sun

Irrigation: High Water Need

Deer Resistant

Can tolerate 32'F

Root: Rhizome

### IV. Butterfly Ginger



# Overview

Latin Name: Hedychium Coronarium

Common Name: White Butterfly Ginger

Origin: Asia

Zones: 7b to 10b

Dormancy: Evergreen in zone 9B

Height: 60" tall

Culture: Sun to Part Sun

Water: Likes it moist

Fertilizer: Fertilize 3 times a year - in

spring, summer and fall

### v. Siam Tulip/Curcuma



# Overview

- Curcuma Alismatifolia
- Aka: Siam tulip
- Zone: 8-10
- Size: 18-24" T x 6" wide
- Blooms: June to October
- Light: Partial Shade
- Dormant in winter
- Deer & Rabbit resistant
- Perennial
- Rhizomes

### VI. Agapanthus



## Overview

- Latin Name: Agapanthus Africanus
- Common Name: Lily of the Nile
- Native: South Africa
- Bloom time: Summer
- Height: Varies by variety
- Width: Varies by variety
- Exposure: Sun/ Light shade
- Evergreen or semi-evergreen depending on species
- Irrigation: water regularly
- Rhizomes
- Deer Love it!

### Overview

Native to: South Africa

Zone: 10 - 12 ?

Height: 3.5 - 4.0

Spread: 3-4'

Bloom Time: Seasonal bloomer

Sun: Full sun to part shade

Water: Medium

Leaf: Evergreen

Tolerates: Drought

Common Name: Giant Calla Lily

Native: South Africa

Height: 2-3'Width: 4-5'

Exposure: Prefers part shade

Irrigation: Moisture loving


Bloom time: Starting in winter Year-

# Overview

Latin Name: Iris Albicans

Common Name: White Flag, Cemetery Iris

Native: Middle East

Zone: 7-9

Bloom time: March-mid spring

Evergreen

Height: 12-24"

Width: 18-24"

♦ Bloom Size: 2-3"

Exposure: Sun

 Water: Tolerates drought once established

Root: Rhizome

Deer: Deer & Rabbit resistant

#### X. Cast Iron Plant

### Overview

- Latin name Aspidistra
- Common name: Cast Iron Plant
- Size:2-3'Tx1-2'W\*
- Part shade to full shade
- Propagates via tubers.
- Likes dry shade. Drought tolerant.
- Reduce watering in winter
- Evergreen
- Deer & Rabbit resistant
- Companion plants: Ferns



### XI. Iris Regina



### Overview

- Latin Name: Iris Neomarica Caerulea 'Regina',
- Common : Poor Man's Orchid
- Native: Brazil
- Bloom time: Feb-Aug
- Size: 3-5 T x 2-3' W
- Light: Full sun- Part shade
- Water: Well drained, moderately moist, never soggy, soil.
- Hardiness: Zone 8B +

### XII. Iris Japonica (NOT Japanese Iris)



## Overview

- Latin Name: Iris Japonica
- Common name: Fringed Iris
- Native to: Asia
- Zone: 7-9
- Size: 1' T x 1-1.5' W
- Bloom Time: May to June
- Light: Part shade-Shade
- Water: Medium
- Leaf: Evergreen
- Tolerates: Deer
- Root: Rhizome
